GRACE CHURCH HAS BEEN BLESSED AND ENTRUSTED WITH MUCH!

On the morning of July 9, 1961 a small handful of men, women and children met to worship together in the basement of a home on Grove Street in West Normal. They had heard the voice of God and were obediently following what He was leading them to do. And they were ever so hopeful that their faithfulness would result in a church where people would come to know, love and serve their Heavenly Father.

Some 50 years later, the campus of Grace Church stands less than three blocks from that house. Those 12 people have become a congregation numbering over 600 men, women and children who serve and are ministered to on a regular basis.

Over those 50 years God has formed us into:

A PRAYING CHURCH

Where we enter into Christ centered worship each week Where we pray with and for each other

A REACHING CHURCH

Sharing the Gospel with our OIKOS Sharing the love of Christ through ministries like Awana, Angel Food and our Deacon Fund

A TEACHING CHURCH

Starting with our Worship Service and continuing through our ABF's, Small Groups, Children's and Student Ministries.

A SERVING CHURCH

Where Biblical Fellowship is encouraged and actively pursued The church family ministers to one another through a variety of ministries.

A SENDING CHURCH

Since we brought on our first missionary in 1964, we have added over 40 more who serve around the globe. We regularly send individuals and groups on short term missionary trips to places like Romania, Guatemala, Netherlands and India.

They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer... praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

- Maximize our outreach to our OIKOS as we continue to expand our ministry to effectively and consistently touch the lives of 1% of the people of Bloomington/Normal.
- Increase our service to our community by lovingly meeting the many various needs found there.
- · Begin a Preschool that reaches both believing and unchurched families.
- Increase our Missionary budget from 15% to 30% of our total giving as we reach the various parts of the Globe with the Gospel through a growing Missionary Family.
- Have additional resources and staff for Reaching and Teaching our community to the glory of God.

WHAT IS BEING ASKED OF ME... HOW DO I GET INVOLVED IN MUCH & MORE?

BE INFORMED – Take time to understand the endeavor by attending an information meeting.

STUDY – Read and reflect on the devotional and other materials provided on Biblical stewardship.

THEN TAKE THESE THREE STEPS:

PRAY - Ask God to show you how He wants you to be involved in Much & More

LISTEN – Wait patiently for direction from the Holy Spirit

OBEY – Step out in obedience to act on His direction

WHAT ARE THE WAYS I CAN GIVE TO MUCH & MORE?

Give a cash gift. Ask God for creative ways to maximize your gift! You might consider giving from your savings, tax refunds, or a garage sale. You could find a way to reduce your expenses and give that amount or defer a major purchase as a sacrifice to God. Look for ways to involve your whole family in giving a specific amount.

Make a 36-month Giving Pledge. The Bible teaches that spiritual maturity includes developing the discipline of regular giving. Giving the first portion of our income is a key way we show God really has first place in our lives. You gift increases more than you think when it is given over a period of time! See the "My Potential Giving" chart.

Give Stocks, Securities or Other Assets. There can be tax advantages to giving assets directly to the church.
