George was born to missionary parents in Brussels, Begium, and returned to the US at the beginning of WWII. After studying in the US, he returned to Belgium in June '52. Dora is Belgian and served with the Salvation Army in London and then Kinshasa from '47-'54. They both taught (part-time for Dora) at the Belgian Bible Institute for 33 years. For 20 of those, George was the school's director.

Besides teaching, George led the students in open-air evangelism and in three church-planting efforts in the 50s and 60s. All of those churches continue on today. George and Dora have been conference speakers in numerous countries over the years. The Winstons resumed church-planting ministry in the 80s and remain in that work.
